

CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS

Parents and Guests: Only campers and staff will be allowed in the dorms after camper's opening camp meeting. Parents and guests attending practice sessions may not enter the practice field or make statements to players or coaches until after practice has ended. Parents and guests attending meetings are there to observe only.

Attending a Herb Haygood Off Season Skills Camp is a privilege. You are expected to follow all camp rules and regulations, both written below and those stated verbally at camp. Your personal safety is our primary concern. You represent your family, school and community and we expect the highest quality of behavior from every camper. HERB HAYGOOD OFF SEASON SKILLS CAMP MAINTAINS THE RIGHT TO DISMISS ANY CAMPER FOR JUST CAUSE, INCLUDING VIOLATING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS BELOW WITHOUT REFUND.

1. It is your responsibility to notify the Camp Director of any problem or concern that you may have regarding ANY aspect of your camp experience. "If we don't know, we can't fix it."
2. Profanity, hazing, threatening or bullying behavior, off-color jokes, references to race, creed, ethnicity, nationality, religion, individual appearance, personal preferences or any other distinction WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
3. Unauthorized room changes are prohibited.
4. Campers are responsible for maintaining their room and common lodge areas (lounges, hallways, stairs, etc.) in the same condition as they were found at the start of camp. Any alteration to the original condition of the dorms when you arrived including, but not limited to, damage, excessive litter, furniture that's been moved, etc. is prohibited. All furniture must be returned to its location when you arrived at camp. Costs incurred will be to those who were responsible.
5. As soon as you enter your room after checking in, look it over thoroughly for any pre-existing damage including broken furniture & windows, missing or torn screens (never remove screens), etc. If there is any pre-existing damage it is your responsibility to fill out the "Room Damage" form from the Camp Director at check-in and fill it out with your roommate(s) and return it to the Camp Director prior to the first practice. This will protect your from being assessed room damage charges for which you are not responsible.
6. Keep your room neat and clean throughout camp. Before checking out of camp on the last day every camper's room will be thoroughly inspected by his coach/counselor for damage, litter, furniture misplacement, etc. After he's approved the overall condition of the room he will give the camper a "Room Check-out" form that he has signed. Take this form to camp check out.
7. Ordering food from off-campgrounds (pizza, Chinese, etc) is strictly forbidden. A snack bar operated by the host campground will be open each day.
8. Be alert and cautious to traffic while walking to and from practice, meals and meetings. Always walk with a buddy. Cross streets with caution. You are prohibited to be in any areas other than those designated by the Camp Director. You will not accept rides from anyone.
9. Every camper is expected to participate in all scheduled activities including every practice, meeting and meal, and to arrive at least five minutes early for every camp activity. Only the athletic trainer and Camp Director can give a camper permission to be absent or late from any camp event. If you are unable to practice you will be expected to follow your position group and learn as much as your can by watching.
10. Drugs of any type or form, including alcohol, other drugs, and all tobacco products are strictly forbidden.
11. Firecrackers, explosive, firearms, weapons of any kind, and gambling or games involving money are strictly forbidden.
12. Turn off all electricity when your leave your room including lights, radios and fans.
13. Herb Haygood Off Season Skills is not responsible for any lost or stolen personal belongings. Campers must be vigilant in protecting their own property, valuables, and money. The campground does not offer "banking" services.
14. Unless there is fire, do not TOUCH fire fighting equipment including alarms, extinguishers, hoses, valves, etc. Check and memorize the fire escape routes from your dorm room and other buildings that we use on the campground.
15. Campers will be prohibited from leaving camp without written permission from the Camp Director. After lights are out the only reason to leave your room is to go to the bathroom or to contact your coach/counselor.
16. If you become sick or injured you must see the athletic trainer, a coach on staff, or Camp Director immediately! Staff will have their names posted on their room door to help you locate them.
17. Driving and riding as a passenger in a motor vehicle during camp is prohibited unless permission is received from the Camp Director. If a camper has driven his own car to camp and is leaving it at the camp he must turn in his car keys to the Camp Director after checking in. Campers walk everywhere during camp.
18. Pre-existing injuries/illnesses/medical conditions (i.e. asthma, allergies, diabetes, epilepsy, etc.) shall be reported to the Camp Director prior to the first practice. Herb Haygood Off Season Skills will not participate in holding or giving prescription medications to any camper.
19. Loud noise from yelling, radios and CD players are prohibited. Always show respect to your roommate(s) and other campers in the dorm. Quiet time, rest and sleep between practices and at night are extremely important.
20. During meals your are welcome to go back for seconds...provided you eat everything on your plate. No wasted food, please. Food cannot be taken out of the cafeteria unless you are eating on the patio. No coolers or ice chests in the cafeteria. Wash hands before meals. Shoes or sandals and a shirt are required (no football cleats). Hats or caps are not to be worn anytime indoors at meals and camp meetings.
21. Drink plenty of water at meals and between and during practice. Avoid soft drinks and other caffeinated beverages. Bring your own squirt bottle to practice where water and Gatorade will be provided.
22. No littering. We are guests of the campground and we want to show respect for the entire campground, including the buildings and grounds and staff, during our stay.
23. Early checkouts are permitted only, when the camper's parent or legal guardian has completed the "Early Checkout Form" and submitted it to the Camp Director. Forms are available from the Camp Director. Campers are prohibited from leaving camp for meals or other reasons unless in an emergency.
